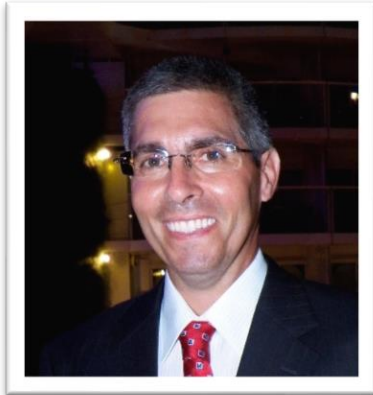




# Kenneth Fisher
